Physics In-Person Activities

Effective May 14, 2021

We are fortunate again to be able to evolve our in-person activities. This policy is a next step in our pandemic response, and further evolution in policies and procedures are anticipated per communication from the university administration. Working in Chamberlin and Sterling offices, labs and shared spaces is encouraged provided the guidelines below are respected.

- Consistent with the recently announced campus COVID recommendation, all students
 and employees are encouraged to maintain a green Badger Badge. There are some
 locations at the university that continue to require the green badge. In the physics
 department it is likely that some shared spaces, laboratories, multi-person offices and
 conference rooms, may require the green badge. If this applies to you more information
 will be forthcoming to you.
- As a reminder, there are two ways to obtain green status on your badge:
 - o First, you may get tested with sufficient frequency that the badge stays green.
 - Second, you may get immunized, which will turn your badge green permanently and remove the need to get tested.
- Face covering masks must be worn at all times, except when you work alone in a room.
- 6-ft social distancing must be observed at all times, following the university guidelines.
- Use of the Marauder's Map is no longer required, however:
 - The map will still be active and supported.
 - For instance, those in shared offices can use it to coordinate time-shared access to their space, when the occupancy does not permit social distancing.
- When the building is locked, access is with a key card.
