WIPAC In-Person Activities

Effective June 2, 2021

We are revising the guidelines for returning to WIPAC at 222 West Washington based on the <u>campus guidelines for the summer of 2021</u>. WIPAC policy will be updated as needed to be consistent with campus policy and procedures.

All people working and/or visiting WIPAC must:

- Have a green Badger Badge by getting tested with sufficient frequency or getting vaccinated (<u>report this to UHS if done off campus</u>), which turns your badge green permanently.
- Following the <u>University Policy</u> "Fully vaccinated people will no longer be required to wear face coverings in most indoor spaces on the UW–Madison campus."
- Maintain 6-ft social distancing at all times.
- We are reviewing the use of the <u>Marauder's Map</u>. Currently we are still requiring
 accesses to be reported and coordinated through the app, primarily now to help people
 assess the risk in planning accesses.
- Schedule conference rooms that are large enough to allow for social distancing as necessary for meetings(Black Hole: 5, Neutrino: 7, Supernova: 12 using seating along walls).
- Follow the <u>requirements from Fiore</u>:
 - The building is open. Floor 5 requires a FOB.
 - Masks are still required in the building. More advanced filters and air purification is in place in the air handlers on each floor.
 - Only two ride in an elevator at a time.
- Continue to keep break rooms clean and ready for use by next person

Remote Work Policies

The University has issued a new Remote Work Policy, effective August 1, 2021. WIPAC will be issuing center-specific guidance.
